



Funding Options

FAC

Funding from Funds Allotment Council (FAC) is awarded a semester in advance (i.e. funding for spring program is awarded in fall; funding for fall is awarded in spring).

Applications are found on the FAC website, and must be submitted by the deadline to be considered. Funding is **only** available to Recognized Student Organizations (RSOs) in good standing with the U&I. Organizations can apply for up to \$5,000 in funding. Not all applications may be funded or funded for the requested amount.

If funding is awarded, FAC will assign a liaison to connect with the organization to ensure checkpoints and requirements are met.

Student Government

Student Government allots a portion of their budget for student program funding. Funding is available to RSOs in good standing with the U&I, and individual full-time students.

For 2021-2022 the maximum available funding that can be awarded is \$650. Applicants must submit an application 3 weeks prior to the event or purpose of funding. Not all applications may be funded or funded for the requested amount.

MOPIP

Truman receives funding from a state entity called “Partners in Prevention” (PIP). This funding comes for a variety of regulatory and prevention agencies such as Gaming, Education, Alcohol, Drug Abuse, etc.

As part of their annual strategic plan, Truman’s PIP Coalition makes funding available to student organizations if they can share a direct connection to the strategic plan in place for the academic year.

Not all applications may be funded or funded for the requested amount. Funding via PIP depends on receiving funds from the state and requirements of the strategic plan.
